PRIVACY POLICY

Updated on 13 December 2023

This Policy sets out the rules for the protection of individuals, including employees, in relation to the processing of their personal data by or on behalf of the Joint Controllers referred to as Consortium Members (N-BIG, CSIC, BITRI, NUST, CCF, EKASI, CELIGNIS, CARBON CAPITAL) with the name SteamBioAfrica)

This policy refers to a set of web data/information collected from SteamBioAfrica website. SteamBioAfrica ("we," "our," or "us") is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how your personal information is collected, used, and disclosed by SteamBioAfrica. Safeguarding your personal information is important to SteamBioAfrica and recognises the responsibility you entrust us providing your personal data. This privacy policy details how your personal data will be used by SteamBioAfrica from the website (https://www.steambioafrica.com)

Definitions and key terms

To help explain things as clearly as possible in this Privacy Policy, every time any of these terms are referenced, are strictly defined as:

- **Cookie:** An amount data generated by a website and saved by your web browser. It is used to identify your browser, provide analytics, remember information about you such as your language preference or login information.
- IP address: Every device connected to the Internet is assigned "an identifier" known
 as an Internet protocol (IP) address. These identifiers are usually assigned in
 geographic blocks. An IP address can often be used to identify the location from which
 a device is connecting to the Internet.



- **Company:** When this policy mentions 'Company', 'we', 'us', or 'our', it refers to https://www.steambioafrica.com/project-overview, which is responsible for your information under this Privacy Policy.
- **Country**: where SteamBioAfrica or the owners/founders of SteamBioAfrica are based, in this case "EU Horizon 2020 grant funded project under grant no 101036401",
- Customer: refers to the company, organization or person that signs up to use the SteamBioAfrica Service to manage the relationships with your consumers or service users.
- **Device:** any internet-connected device such as a phone, computer, tablet, or any other device that can be used to visit SteamBioAfrica and use the services.
- **Service:** refers to the service provided by SteamBioAfrica as described in the relative terms (if available) and on this platform.
- Third-party service: refers to advertisers, contest sponsors, promotional and marketing partners, and others who provider content or whose products or services we think may interest you.
- **Website:** SteamBioAfrica's site, which can be accessed via this URL: https://www.steambioafrica.com
- You: a person or entity that is registered with SteamBioAfrica to use the Services.



What Information Do We Collect?

We collect information from you when you visit our website, register on our visitor application, or fill out a form. The following information may be obtained.

- Name and Surname
- Email Addresses
- Company
- Country
- Age
- Gender
- Visual material such as photographs of partners and site visitors

When does SteamBioAfrica use end-user information from third parties?

SteamBioAfrica will collect the End User Data necessary to provide the SteamBioAfrica services to our customers. End users may voluntarily provide us with information they have made available on social media websites. If you provide us with any such information, we may collect publicly available information from the social media websites you have indicated. You can control how much of your information social media websites will be made public by indicating on the digital forms or via our survey link on our visitor iPad or on your mobile phone.

When does SteamBioAfrica use customer information from third parties?

We receive some information from third parties when you contact us. For example, when you submit your email address to us to show interest in becoming an affiliate. W receive information from a third party that provides automated fraud-detection services to SteamBioAfrica. We also occasionally collect information that is made publicly available on social media websites. You can control how much of your information is shared that is collected from social media websites by changing your privacy settings.



Do we share the information we collect with third parties?

We may share the information that we collect, both personal and non-personal, with third parties such as advertisers, contest sponsors, promotional and marketing partners, and others who provide content or whose products or services we think may interest you. We may also share it with our current and future affiliated companies and business partners, and if we are involved in a merger, asset sale or other business reorganization, we may also share or transfer your personal and non-personal information to our successors-in-interest.

We may engage trusted third-party service providers to perform functions and provide services to us, such as hosting and maintaining our servers and the website, database storage and management, e-mail management, storage marketing and customer service. We will likely share your personal information, and possibly some non-personal information, with these third parties to enable them to perform these services for us and you.

We may share portions of our log file data, including IP addresses, for analytics purposes with third parties such as web analytics partners, application developers, and ad networks. If your IP address is shared, it may be used to estimate general location and other technographics such as connection speed, whether you have visited the website in a shared location, and type of the device used to visit the website. They may aggregate information about our advertising and what you see on the website and then provide auditing, research and reporting for us and our advertisers.

Where and when is information collected from visitors and end users?

SteamBioAfrica will collect personal information that you submit to us. We may also receive personal information about you from third parties as described above.

How do we use the information we collect?

Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- For market data research, visitor statistics and for other marketing purposes
- To improve our website (we continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you)
- To improve our service (your information helps us to respond to your individual requests and support needs) more effectively
- To administer a contest, promotion, survey, or other site feature
- To send periodic emails

How do we use your email address?

We only send emails to people who have authorised us to contact them via the visitor forms or through the link to the online survey forms. E-mails may be sent either directly, or through a third party. We do not send unsolicited commercial emails, because we hate spam as much as you do. By submitting your email address, you also agree to allow us to use your email address for customer audience targeting on sites like Facebook, where we display custom advertising to specific people who have opted-in to receive communications from us.

How long do we keep your information?

We keep your information only so long as we need it to provide **SteamBioAfrica-related content** to you and fulfil the purposes described in this policy. This is also the case for anyone that we share your information with and who conducts services on our behalf. When we no longer need to use your information and there is no need for us to keep it to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, we will either remove it from our systems or depersonalise it so that we can't identify you.



How Do We Protect Your Information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you place an order or enter, submit, or access your personal information.

Could my information be transferred to other countries?

Information collected via our website, through direct interactions with you, or from the use of our help services may be transferred from time to time to our offices or personnel, or third parties, located throughout the world, and may be viewed and hosted anywhere in the world, including countries that may not have laws of general applicability regulating the use and transfer of such data. To the fullest extent allowed by applicable law, by using any of the above, you voluntarily consent to the trans-border transfer and hosting of such information.

Is the information collected through the SteamBioAfrica Service secure?

We take precautions to protect the security of your information. We have physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to help safeguard, prevent unauthorized access, maintain data security, and correctly use your information. However, neither people nor security systems are foolproof, including encryption systems. In addition, people can commit intentional crimes, make mistakes or fail to follow policies. Therefore, while we use reasonable efforts to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. If applicable law imposes any non-disclaimable duty to protect your personal information, you agree that intentional misconduct will be the standards used to measure our compliance with that duty.

Can I update or correct my information?

You have the rights to request updates or corrections information collected by SteamBioAfrica , you can do this through the Data Protection Officer. Personnel may update or correct their information as detailed in our internal company employment policies. Subject to contacting us in advance, affiliate partners may do the following:

Visitors have the right to request the restriction of certain uses and disclosures of personally identifiable information as follows. You can contact us via our email address to

(1) update or correct your personally identifiable information,



- (2) change your preferences with respect to communications and other information you receive from us, or
- (3) delete the personally identifiable information maintained about you on our systems (subject to the following paragraph) Such updates, corrections, changes, and deletions will have no effect on other information that we maintain, or information that we have provided to third parties in accordance with this Privacy Policy prior to such update, correction, change or deletion.

Promptly after receiving your request, all personal information stored in databases we actively use, and other readily searchable media will be updated, corrected, changed, or deleted, as appropriate, as soon as and to the extent reasonably and technically practicable.

If you are an end user and wish to update, delete, or receive any information we have about you, you may do so by contacting the organization of which you are a customer.

Affiliates

We may disclose information (including personal information) about you to our Corporate Affiliates. This Privacy Policy is governed by the laws of Namibia, United Kingdom, Botswana and South Africa EU Regulations 2018/1725 including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), without regard to its conflict of laws provision. You consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in connection with any action or dispute arising between the parties under or in connection with this Privacy Policy except for those individuals who may have rights to make claims under Privacy Shield, or the Swiss-US framework.

The laws of of the above mentioned countries excluding its conflicts of law rules, shall govern this Agreement and your use of the website. Your use of the website may also be subject to other local, state, national, or international laws.

By using SteamBioAfrica or contacting us directly, you signify your acceptance of this Privacy Policy. Information about General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We may be collecting and using information from you if you are from the European Economic Area (EEA), and in this section of our Privacy Policy we are going to explain exactly how and why this data is collected, and how we maintain this data under protection from being replicated or used in the wrong way.

What is GDPR?

GDPR is an EU-wide privacy and data protection law that regulates how EU residents' data is protected by companies and enhances the control the EU residents have, over their personal data.
